New Provost Named for Cowell College at UCSC

Santa Cruz -- Professor Jasper Rose will succeed Dr. Page Smith as Provost of Cowell College on the UC, Santa Cruz campus, effective July 1.


Announcement of the appointment was made by UC President Charles J. Hitch and UCSC Chancellor Dean E. McHenry following approval of the UC Regents at their March meeting.

"Professor Rose is a brilliant man who has divided his interests between history and art," said Chancellor Mc-Henry. "He knows members of the college well, and, along with Page Smith, has been in-

strumental in setting the style of Cowell College, the first to open on UCSC's 2,000 acre-Currently on a year's sab-

Currently on a year's sabbatical leave in England, Rose has been a member of the faculty of Cowell College since 1965 and has served as Senior Preceptor of Cowell, where he is also Professor of History and Art, since 1967.

He holds an MA degree from Cambridge University. Prior to his UCSC appointment, he had taught as a Fellow of King's College, Cambridge, and at the University of Keele and Rice University.



RESIGNS AS PROVOST -- Dr. Page Smith announces his resignation as Provost of Cowell College at the University of California, Santa Cruz. Provost Smith indicated that he would be on leave from the University for the 1970-71 academic year working on a history of the period of the American Revolution, and that he planned to return to the University as a Fellow of Cowell College and Professor of Historical Studies in the fall of 1971. "When I undertook to be Provost of Cowell College," said Dr. Smith, "I told Chancellor McHenry that I did not expect to serve in that office for more than four or five years." Dr. Smith has been Provost of UCSC's first College, Cowell, since the campus opened in 1965.
