SC To Honor Employees

A recognition dinner for city employees and their guests will be held Friday at 7:30 p.m. at the Coconut Grove to express the Santa Cruz City Council's appreciation "for the excellent work accomplished during the January storm."

Some 500 to 700 persons are expected to attend, according to Michele Kibrick, City Council aide.

During its budget session last year the City Council indicated it wished to allocate \$5,000 toward a "morale booster" program for the workers. The dinner will serve as the program this year, according to Kent Rice, city personnel director.

The City Council last Tuesday transferred \$8,000 to its budget for training and employee awards.

In another tribute related to the January storm, Mayor Michael Rotkin has issued commendatory proclamations to 14 organizations and individuals who provided valuable aid to the city in coping with various emergencies.
