School Board To Select Site For New Elementary School

Site selection for the proposed West side elementary school is scheduled for discussion during the regular city school district board meeting tomorrow at 7:30 p.m.

The session will be held in the district offices at 133 Mission street.

Santa Cruz city council Thursday evening gave its approval of an 11-acre "alternate" site in the Henry Cowell foundation property north of High street. Six other locations in the Bay-High street area have been given consideration.

Voters last June approved an \$800,000 bond issue including the proposed school.

Other matters for board discussion include:

STADIUM — A request has been made by Cabrillo junior college for use of the Santa Cruz high school stadium. Cabrillo has a nine game 1959 football schedule, including four games which

would be played here on Saturday evenings.
