Adult Theafer Operator Is Again Facing Arrest

A warrant for the arrest of adult movie operator Wallace Von Medlin was re-issued Wednesday afternoon, and if he persists in showing the X-rated movies at Cinema Soquel, he'll go to jail, the sheriff's office said this morning.

The movies were running this morning, according to a ticket office worker, and Von Medlin told The Sentinel, "I don't know

what I'm going to do."

He'll go to jail, a spokesman for the sheriff's office said, if deputies find the movies are running when they check it out today.

Superior Court Judge Donald O. May told Von Medlin on July 2 to either stop showing the movies or sit it out in jail while they run.

May found Von Medlin in contempt of a court order issued early this year that told him to close down by June 5, since he was in violation of the county's spacing ordinance which controls adult entertainment.

May upheld the spacing ordinance in his decision and the upper courts have refused to hear the case, thereby upholding May's decision.

Von Medlin bought a little time while the state Supreme Court made up its mind not to hear the case, but Wednesday, the court's patience and the county's patience apparently ran out.

Just this week, in an attempt to get around the county's ordinance Von Medlin, turned his operation at Cinema Soquel, which he leases, into a private club.

Also in that club is Frenchy's adult book store which recently was found in violation of its use permit and the permit was canceled by the county Board of Supervisors.

Frenchy's is bound for local court in the near future, according to County Counsel Clair Carlson. Its earlier court suit that set conditions for the use permit is at the appeal level, but it is expected Carlson will go to court to close the store on its violation of the use permit.
