

New Library System Due At Twin Lakes

Mrs. C. D. Eshleman, Twin Lakes branch librarian, announced today that an entirely new system of charging books will go into effect in the near future, doing away with a complicated system used for the past 17 years.

Mrs. Eshleman stated: "We are taking a complete inventory of all books we have and will weed out the old ones, bringing in new titles for our readers.

"A great improvement will be the registering of everyone in the county who will be given a borrower's identification card. With that card they can borrow as many books as they can read in a week. Their identification will also include, if they wish, a brief statement as to hobbies and books they are most interested in. Those cards we will study and keep in mind when we purchase new ones."

Fifty late editions by popular authors have already arrived at the library and are ready for use, Mrs. Eshleman declared.
