Graham Hill Grounds For Sale

A price tag of \$1 million has been put on the Graham Hill Horse Show Grounds and it is now officially on the market for sale.

Owned by the Cowell Foundation, the front portion of the grounds has been used for equestrian events — including steeple chase racing at an earlier time — since the 1920s.

Announcement for a sale was made by M. C. Hall and Sons, the real estate firm handling the property.

Hall said today his firm has given "first opportunity to purchase" to local horsemen's

associations.

Roberta Patterson, member of the San Lorenzo Valley Horsemen's Association, said, "The organizations in this county don't have that much money, and probably we'll petition the county board of supervisors to see if the county can buy the land."

The rolling meadow lands, holding the fenced show area and bleachers, can be seen from Graham Hill Road, in the area of the Lockwood Lane T - intersection.

The grounds have been named in the county Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan as an area that would be "an extremely valuable public park."

Hall said there have been no firm offers, but that there are a number of perspective buyers who have shown interest in the property.
