Supervisors get a raise

SANTA CRUZ — County supervisors have given themselves raises equal to those recently granted to the majority of

county employees.

The raises, approved unanimously by supervisors Tuesday, increase their salaries by \$25 a month beginning Jan. 14, 1984. Their pay increases by another \$45 a month starting July 14, 1984 and by \$112 a month on Aug. 11, 1984.

This means supervisors' salaries will go from the present \$2,167 a month to \$2,192 on Jan. 14. They then will go up to \$2,237 on July 14 and up to \$2,349 on Aug.

The chairman of the board will continue to get an additional \$100 a month.

The raises coincide with those granted to the 1,200 county employees represented by the Service Employees International Union, Local 415.
