The money will be used specifically to repair presented to Supervisors Eureka Canyon Road above Corralitos, and by Samuel R. Pierce Jr., Lompico, Felton-Empire, Jarvis and East Zavante Roads in the San Lorenzo Valley area.

HUD officials approved the grant, county offi-Dan cials said, because they pose an imminent threat to public safety and their repair will benefit low and moderate income families.

> The sudden infusion of the federal money will allow the county to extend its road repair efforts this year to roads not now earmarked for

repair.

The grant, according to County Public Works Director Don Porath will have a ripple effect, and allow the county accelerate its repairs on roads not presently scheduled for repair this year.

The county has a damage list that includes 109 county-maintained roads, with repairs estimated to cost \$9,232,000.
