With an 85% sign-up of eligible City employees the new extended benefit CPS Plan became effective October 1st. It was necessary that a minimum of 75% be obtained.

It is now too late to join the Plan without a medical statement. Applications were accepted from members of Santa Cruz City Civil Service Association up to October 12th with blanket inclusion and no questions asked. After October 12th Association members may join the plan at any time but medical histories of the entire family must be furnished.

The new CPS Plan provides many new benefits. A \$300 drug rider is included along with unlimited X-rays. For the first time in Santa Cruz County, a \$6000 ceiling has been established. All other presently existing CPS Plans in the County have a ceiling not exceeding \$4200.
