
Boulder Creek To Get New Postoffice



March is the target date for completion of the new Boulder Creek postoffice, at the intersection of Pine street and Forest street. Designer and Engineer Norris A. Houk reported the 3000-square foot concrete block building will cost approximately \$40,000, including development of the land. Plans call for the roof to have 50-foot tapered steel beams.
