

BIO-L President Reagan Names Liddicoat To Commission

Former Santa Cruz County Supervisor Marilyn Liddicoat has been named to the National Commission on Student Financial Assistance by President Ronald Reagan.

Liddicoat, who makes her home in Corralitos, was named to the commission Friday. She was one of four presidential appointments.

The group was set up to study ways of providing financial assistance to college students.

The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Senate Majority Leader also will appoint four members each. The commission will be chaired by David Jones of Vanderbilt University.

Liddicoat is not expected to move from the area.

She and her husband, Doug, were strong supporters of Reagan's candidacy. Her husband was county co-chairman of the Reagan campaign.
