Celebrate the last hurrah of summer beside the beach in Capitola, strolling the Esplanade while enjoying the works of 200 local and visiting artists, wine tasting from

21 exceptional Santa Cruz Mountain wineries, free admission and easy parking with a shuttle available at the Capitola Mall and the Capitola Beach Shuttle operating from the Crossroads Center. Attendees will enjoy gourmet food from local restaurants and caterers, browse through exquisite artwork while listening to live music and enjoying a great line-up of exciting entertainment.

At the Capitola Art & Wine Festival, patrons can taste great wines from Bargetto Winery, Hallcrest Vineyards, Roudon-Smith Winery and many more. Local restaurants in attendance include Café Carlos, E & J Catering, Falafel of Santa Cruz and Café Cruz, among others.

Red Beans & Rice kicks off the live music on the Capitola Bandstand at 2:30 PM on Saturday followed by LED ZEPHAIN - a tribute to Led Zeppelin at 5:00 PM.
