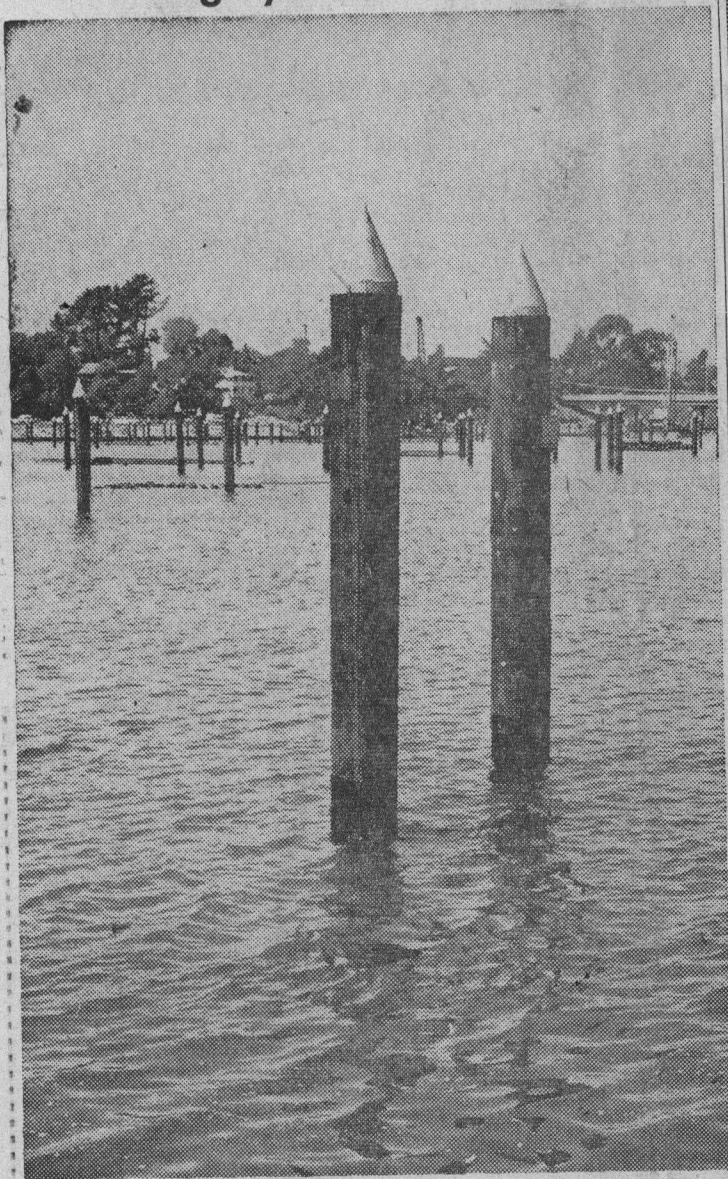

## Mighty Uncomfortable



Seagulls, as picturesque as they may be, are not welcome at the new Santa Cruz harbor. To discourage the birds, each piling of the harbor is being equipped with a cone-like galvanized tin top. The sharp point is highly uncomfortable for gulls.

Engineers of the project reported that the effects were immediate. Before the tin devices were installed, gulls were on "nearly every piling." Since then, gulls have moved to more hospitable areas.
