SC Police Close New Book Store

At 11 a.m. Saturday, Frenchy's K and T Adult Book Store, 1013 Pacific Ave., opened for business. The men are scheduled to appear in Santa Cruz Municipal Court on Monday at 1:30 p.m.

At about 2 p.m., Santa Cruz police officers, led by Lt. Charles Scherer, arrested a clerk and an owner of the establishment, which then was closed. A quantity of materials depicting various sexual acts was confiscated by officers, Lt. Scherer said.

The action was taken under Section 311.2 of the California Penal Code which prohibits offering obscene matter for sale. Violation of the penal code section is a misdemeanor that carries a maximum penalty of \$500 or six months in the county jail, or both, upon conviction, he said.

Arrested and released on their own recognizance were Earl Stanley Kuhns, 41, of San Jose, a co-owner, and his clerk, Richard Anthony Castner, 36, also of San Jose. A complaint also is being sought against Kuhn's partner, Jack Topler, Lt. Scherer said.

The pair is operating a similar store in San Mateo, he added.
