SANTA CRUZ — Dog lovers have a new place to pamper their pooches now that Puppy Breath Boutique has opened

The business will hold its grand opening Friday. Owner Emily Kay previously worked as a dog trainer as well as a veterinarian technician at a pet hospital before she decided to open the business.

"I only started planning this in April," Kay said. "I thought do it now or don't do it at all." Her own dog Ishi, part English mastiff, part Kangal, will keep her company at the store.

"Now that dogs are allowed on Pacific Avenue it definitely opened up an opportunity," Kay said. "We're eco-friendly and organic, continuing in Santa Cruz tradition." Previously, dogs were not allowed on Pacific Avenue, but a change in city ordinance now permits them as long as they stay on a leash.

The store stocks a variety of dog treats and accessories, ranging from groom-

ing products to leashes.
"All the treats are handmade with natural ingredients, such as rice, pumpkin and flaxseed," Kay said. "We provide the tools to create a healthy, happy lifestyle for the dog."

The store also offers a variety of services, such as in-home and behavioral training.

Although the grand opening is Friday, the store has been open for three weeks and has already received favorable comments from customers.

"I went in there on a whim; I didn't know about the boutique at all," said Shantya Martinez, of Boulder Creek. "It's pretty cute and affordable, and a good location because there are a lot of dogs that walk around here.'
