

Big water parade tops festival slate

Entry forms are now available for "Fairytale" — the 1977 edition of the Capitola National Begonia Festival's water parade. The water parade, culminating a week of activities, will be held on Soquel Creek Sunday, Sept. 11. Application forms are available from the Capitola city hall, the Chamber of Commerce office, Craft Gallery and the Bell, Book and Candle store in Capitola

village. The celebration gets underway the preceding Sunday, Sept. 4, with a sand sculpture contest on Capitola beach. Drawing more than 200 entries last year, registration will begin at 8 a.m. this year and judging at 2 p.m. Three new children's categories have been opened this year, said festival president Jerry Clarke, and there will be lots of prizes for the best designs. The theme is up to each sculptor.

For the toddlers and their parents, the diaper derby registration starts at 10 a.m. Sept. 4. Babies race the clock over a fixed distance, to the encouragement of their parents. It will be held on the Esplanade across from Capitola beach.

Two nautical activities are planned for Labor Day Monday. At 10 a.m., rowboat races get underway off the Capitola wharf with juniors competing first. Adults — mixed doubles — compete in a do-or-die contest at noon.

The little Jester dinghy sailboats will be racing in the lee of the wharf Monday.

The action shifts back to the Capitola beach Saturday, Sept. 10, with the first Northern California sand volleyball tourney. A pro-am tourney, it's open to everyone. Amateur entry fees are \$5 a team. Pro teams — competing for a minimum \$1,000 cash prize — can enter for \$10.

Eliminations will continue through Sunday, Sept. 11, with finals held after the nautical parade.
