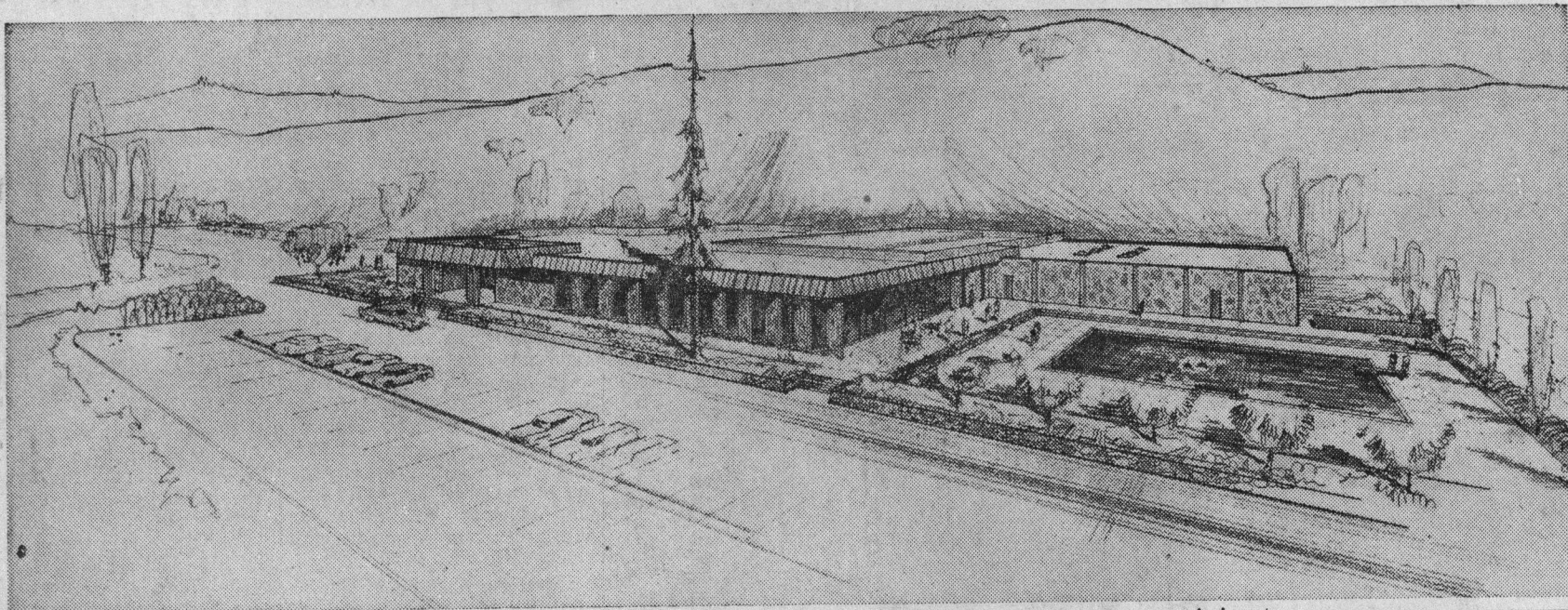


Elks Lodge Gets Planners' Green Light



The Elks lodge has been given a green light by Santa Cruz planners for the proposed \$500,000 center at Jewel and Ocean streets. San Jose architect Norton S. Curtis pre-

pared this sketch showing the 23,000-square-foot, one-story building, complete with swimming pool and parking area. Landscape architect Arthur Hyde of Watsonville has been

retained to handle beautification of the surrounding grounds. Issuance of a building permit awaits only formal action of the city planning commission. At its Wednes-

day meeting, the commission heard James DuMond outline building proposals. Tentative approval and referral to the staff for recommendations was the action then.
