

Forbus Again Clarifies LO Plan Statement

Soquel - Live Oak District Supervisor Dan Forbus Wednesday night affirmed his denial that he had not directed the county planning department to cancel a meeting of the Live Oak General Plan Advisory Committee (LOGPAC) last week.

However, Forbus didn't deny

that he told LOGPAC members at a luncheon meeting that the village center concept the group had been studying "is now dead" and that the county would pull out of that study at this time.

Forbus explained during a meeting on a newly proposed septic tank ordinance Wednesday night, "I can understand how the two issues became

confused, but I had talked to board members prior to the Tuesday meeting (when the denial of the cancellation was made), and they understood what I was talking about."

The controversy of who was responsible for cancelling the LOGPAC citizens meeting was not quite clarified at this week's regular board meeting as both Forbus and County

Planning Director Kay Bowden stated the county had not cancelled the meeting, but only informed LOGPAC members that county staff would not be present the night of the scheduled meeting.

She said that the non-participation had been discussed with Forbus, but that he had not directed her department to take the action.
