

Building Permits \$169,000

A building permit for a \$62,850 skating rink, to be built at Seabright avenue and Gault street, was taken out this week by Mrs. D. R. Sargeant, Building Inspector Malcolm Sinclair announced.

The structure, to be known as "Skaters' Palladium", will have a 180 foot front on Gault street, and 70 foot on Seabright. The plans also provide for three stores on Seabright to be included in the building.

Mrs. Sargeant said this morning that bids for the construction job would be invited today, and that no date for beginning of actual building had been set.

The permit was one of 14 which totaled \$169,545 during the past week, Sinclair reported.
