VACAVILLE, Calif. (AP) — For the third time, convicted serial killer Edmund Kemper has been denied parole.

Kemper, 49, was convicted of killing eight women, including his mother, in Northern California during the early 1970s.

He refused to attend his third parole hearing on Thursday, but sent a statement to the three-member panel from the state Board of Prison Terms saying he should not be released.

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
