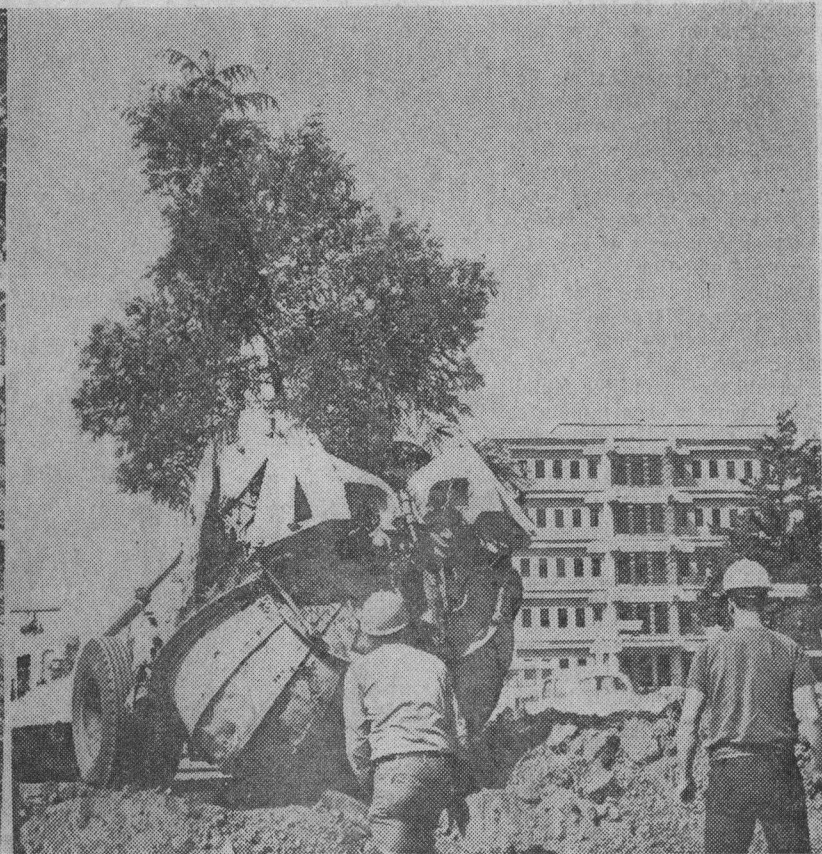
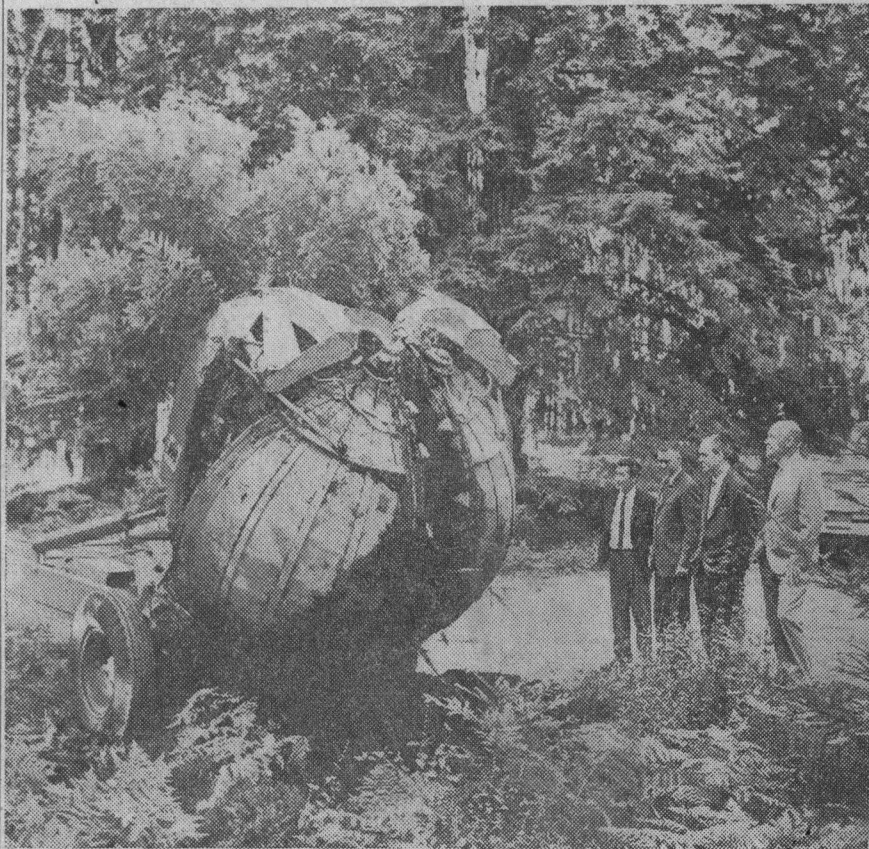

UCSC Trees Go To New Center



The University of California at Santa Cruz has joined other organizations in helping to landscape the new county governmental center grounds. This morning five redwood trees

were removed, photo at left, from the UCSC campus and were transplanted on the county site, at right. UCSC officials watching the tree removal are Harry Tsugawa, assistant landscape architect; Harold Hyde, vice chan-

cellor; Francis Clauser, vice chancellor, and Chancellor Dean McHenry. Tsugawa said redwoods ranged in height from 12 to 25 feet.
