

Library board expansion plan to be debated

A change in the Santa Cruz City Charter that would allow the addition of members to the city/county library system's board of directors will be discussed when the board meets tonight at 7:30 at the Central Branch Library.

Members would likely be added from the cities of Capitola and Scotts Valley, in the event they began contributing money to the library above the property tax monies they now pay. Such contributions might be made, for example, in the event a County Service Area is established to help fund the library.

Also on tonight's agenda is a recommendation that a bi-weekly outreach service be given a six-month trial at Murphy Camp in the Pajaro Valley.

Owner of the farm worker camp, which houses 75 to 100 people year-round, is currently working on bringing it up to health standards.
