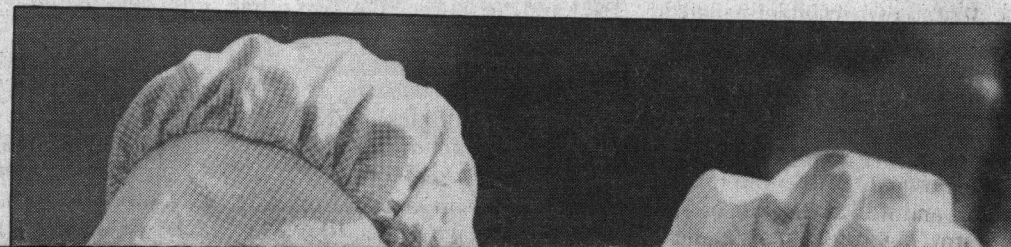


# ***Celebrating a rebirth***

A huge crowd surges into the new Ford's Department Store at grand opening that climaxed yesterday's earthquake observances.



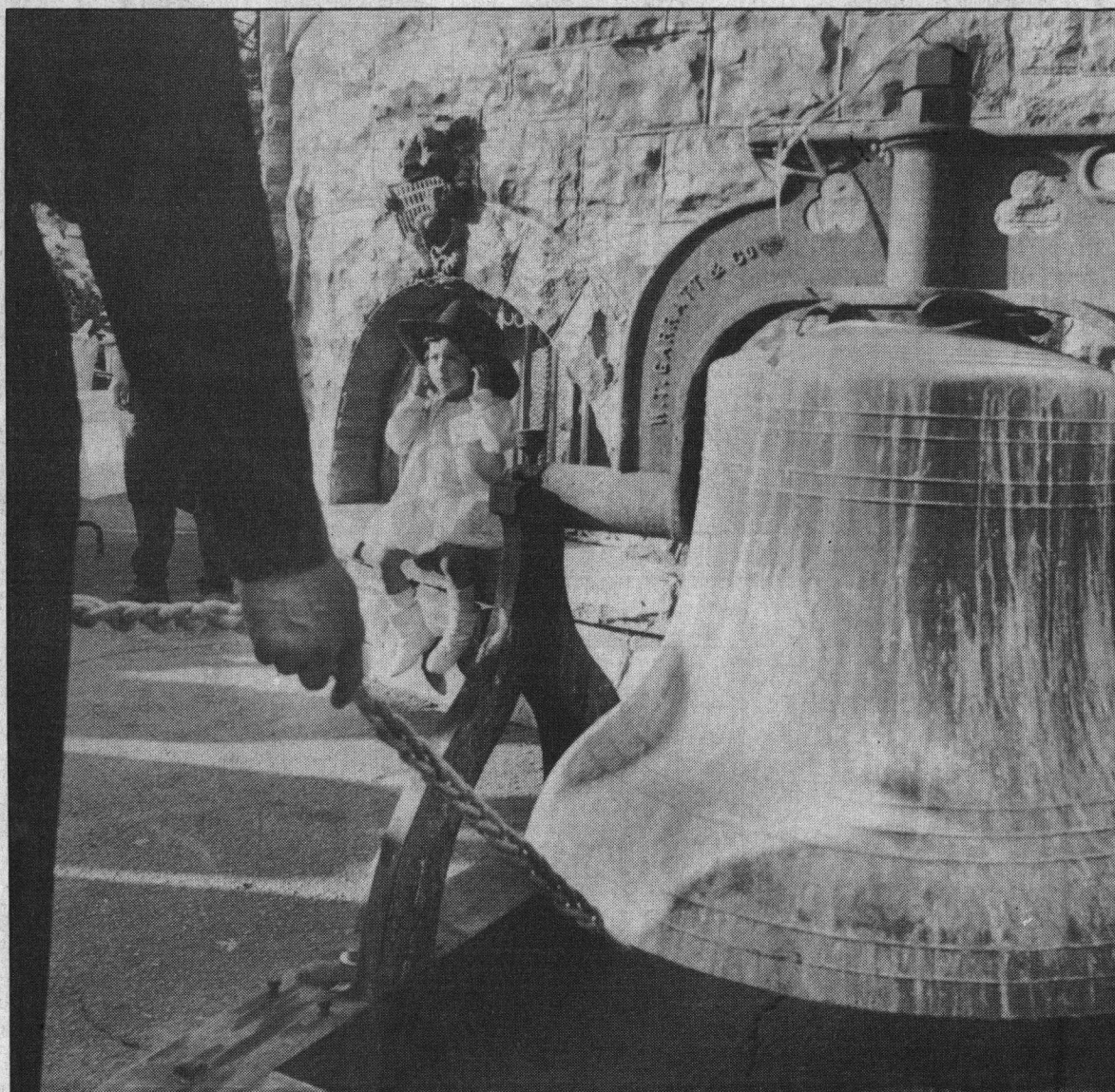




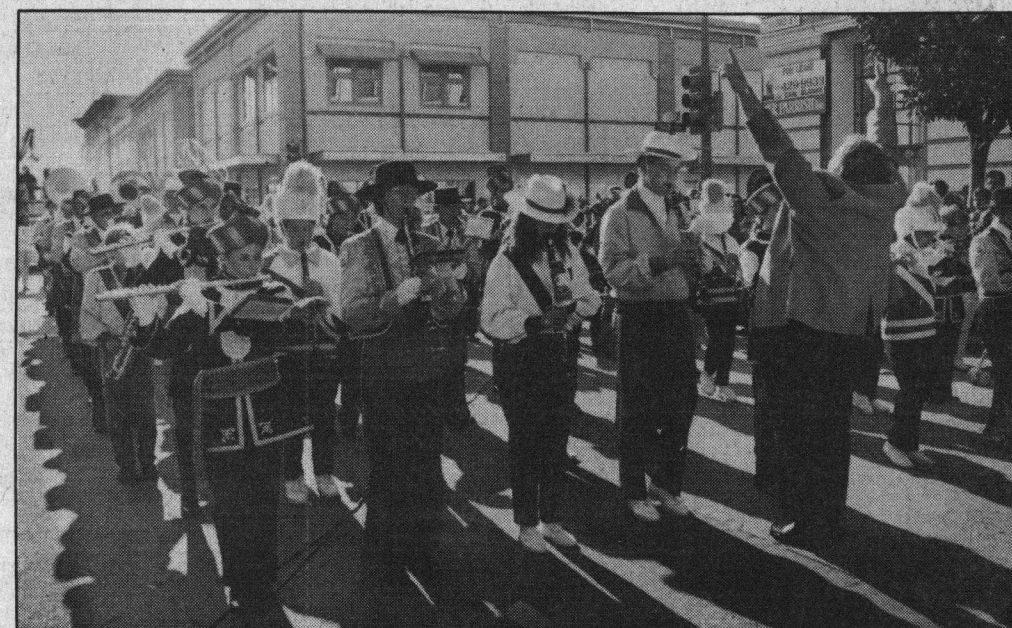
