atsonville Supervisor E. Wayne Moore outspent challenger Mario Carabarin by a 10-1 margin in their June 8 electoral contest.

The incumbent raised \$9,183.62 and spent a little under \$8,000 of it in his successful bid to remain in office. Carabarin raised and spent only \$796 in his campaign. Moore received more than 70% of the votes.

In the surprisingly close race for the right to represent the Santa Cruz district on the Board of Supervisors, spending was fairly even.

Supervisor Gary Patton raised \$15,767 and spent nearly all of it in his successful campaign for a third term in office. Challenger Katy Sears-Williams, who came within a few percentage points of pulling an upset in her first bid for office, raised \$14,784.89 during the campaign. More than \$14,000 of that was spent.
