Library Branch To Be Put In Co. Hospital

Trustees of the public library voted last week to establish a branch at the county hospital. The plan is backed by Librarian Geraldine Work and by the county health officer, Dr. John D. Fuller, who will provide space in the new hospital building.

The books will be taken to the bedside of patients unable to visit the branch library. Two hundred volumes, both fiction and non-fiction, will be put on the shelves immediately, to be added to as demand justifies.
