Working To Restore Power To Greater Santa Cruz Area

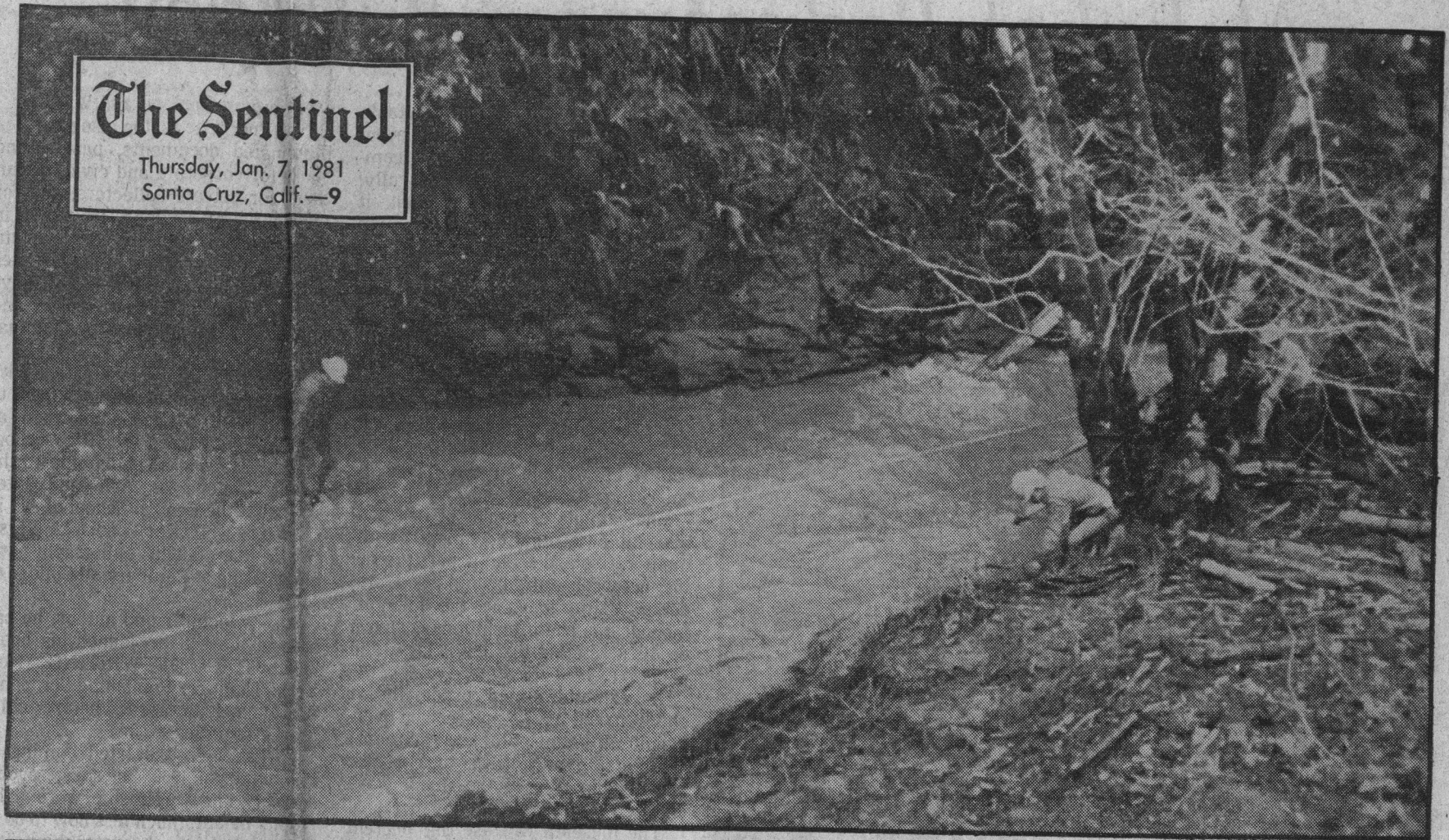
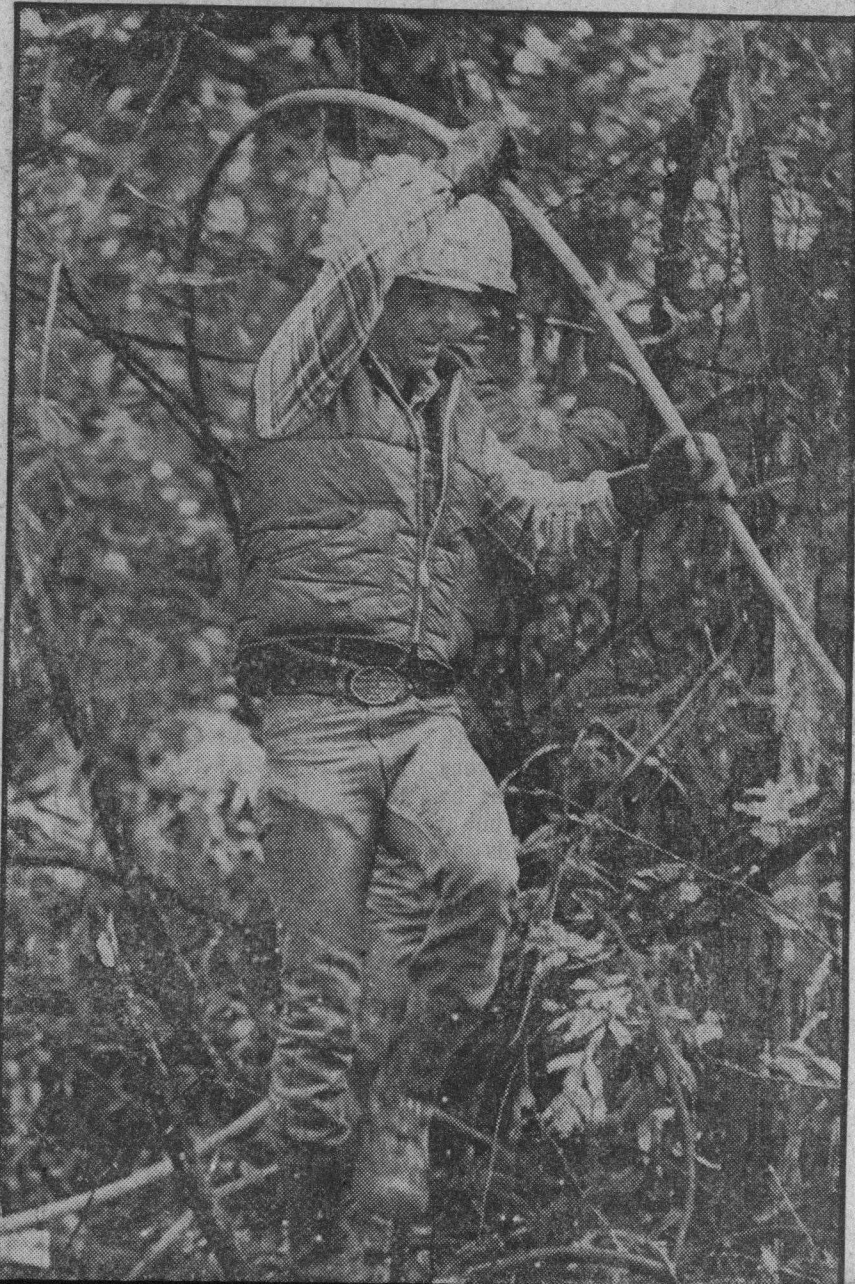
At 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, linemen spliced one of two 110,000-volt lines, restoring

power throughout most of the area. The lines run from Green Valley to the Paul Sweet Road substation, which is the key to power in the Santa Cruz area.

Today, PG&E moved its line crews and equipment to the second line, located almost two miles from the one repaired Wednesday.

ABOVE — Linemen move to stabilize a line.

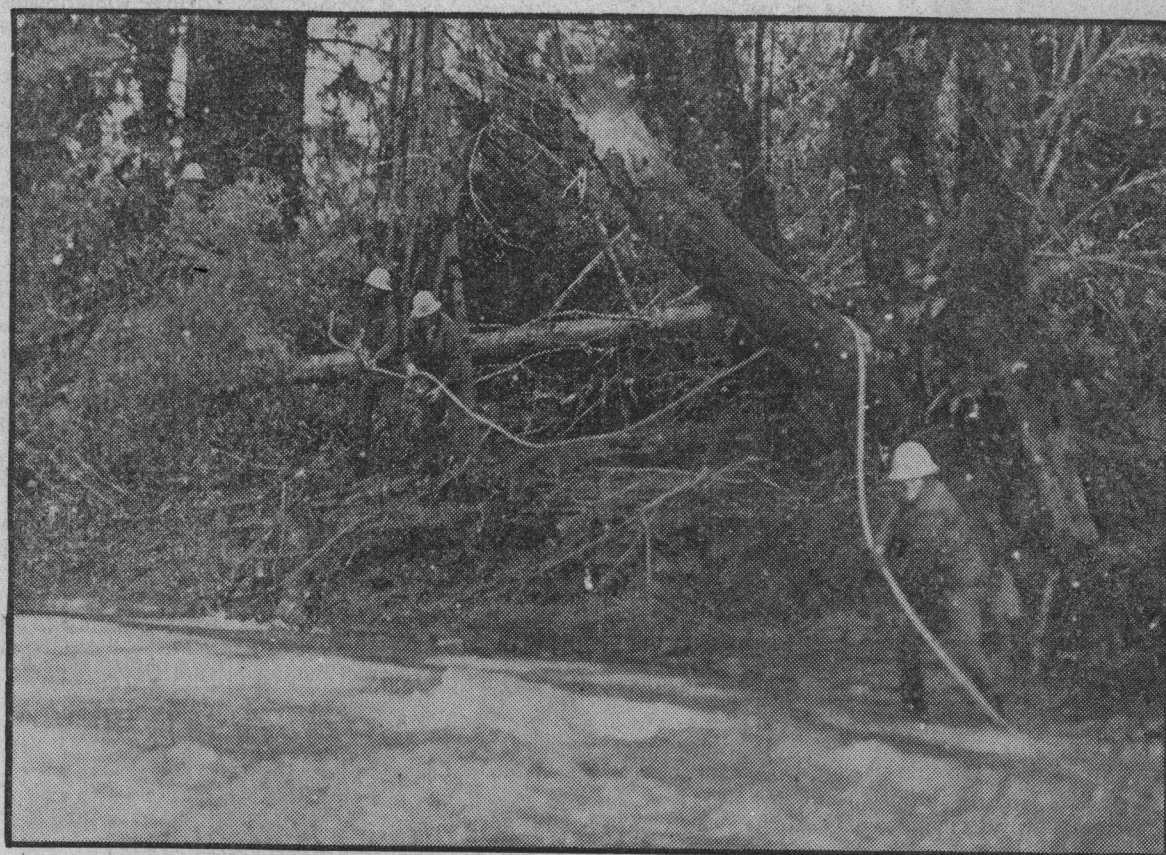
FAR LEFT — Gene Nuckols and Mike Dion manhandle the high-voltage cable.
