


# Working To Restore Power To Greater Santa Cruz Area

PG&E crews, lifted by helicopter into the remote Prescott Road area above Soquel, are shown in these photos repairing the downed power lines which serve the greater Santa Cruz area.

At 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, linemen spliced one of two 110,000-volt lines, restoring power throughout most of the area. The lines run from Green Valley to the Paul Sweet Road substation, which is the key to power in the Santa Cruz area.

Today, PG&E moved its line crews and equipment to the second line, located almost two miles from the one repaired Wednesday.








