

Turner Memorial Library Under Way



A collection of 125 books was presented to the Boulder Creek library yesterday afternoon by a San Lorenzo Valley citizens committee in the name of Dr. Floyd C. Turner, a Boulder Creek research scientist and humanitarian who died more than a year ago. Placing the
