# Conditions Pinned On Aptos Cemetery

County supervisors yesterday drove the final nails into a use permit package for a cemetery-memorial park in the Aptos area known as Larkin Valley.

that the burial plots may be taken off the tax rolls under state law; other persons such as D. N. Knight and Mrs. E. Milsap, objected generally to the use.

Basically, the use permit runs for five years, expiring December 19, 1972, unless renewed. Other conditions set for applicant Edward Madigan include:

—An adequate water supply.

—Deeding Redwood Heights Road to the county and improving it somewhat.

—Deeding a strip along the northern part of the property for a future access roads beyond the 140-acre cemetery. The county has one year to settle on the location of this strip.

Deed frontage along Freedom Boulevard and widen Freedom, if necessary, at the cemetery entrance.

—Planning for each phase of the development of mausoleums, crematorium, and mortuaries must be submitted to the county planning commission for approval.

In other action yesterday, supervisors also adopted a list of rules and regulations for employees in the new governmental center and decided to go ahead with reconstruction of a drainage district near Quail Hollow School in Ben Lomond with assessment district funds.
