## Breakdown of calls to sheriff's office

The Sheriff's Office divides the unincorporated areas of Santa Cruz into six patrol areas or "beats." In 1989, there were 110,169 calls for service recorded by the Sheriff's Office.

A breakdown shows:

- Beat 1 — North San Lorenzo Valley: 11,989 calls, or 11 percent of the total.
- Beat 2 — South San Lorenzo Valley: 12,679, 12 percent.
- Beat 3 — Live Oak and North Coast: 36,847, 33 percent
- Beat 4 — Soquel: 14,698, 13 percent.
- Beat 5 — Aptos: 16,708, 15 percent.
- Beat 6 — Watsonville (Pajaro Valley): 17,248, 16 percent.
