Schools could save money by eliminating their specially-built, tional expensive buses or putting the buses on runs to remote areas. Schools should not "provide school bus service for any student who has access to public transportation." Poor students should be given free bus tickets.

- University students under 21 could buy student bus tickets, but the others would pay full fare. The UCSC bus line is losing \$300 to \$400 per month on the university route, and there is "no justification" for this."
- No route to Cabrillo College should be established until it can "pay its own way."
- Fares should go up a nickel, to 25 cents but regular customers could buy tokens for 20 cents each. School fares would still be the same, 15 cents. Transfers would be free.
