

County Buildings Have Their Ups, Downs



"Going up — and coming down" might be the description of the county's building program from these two pictures. While construction crews began mounting the first pre-stressed ceiling beams for the courthouse complex yesterday, other work crews demolished the old welfare department building further up Water street. The welfare department moved to new quarters at 1218-B Mission street, and will move into the \$6 million governmental center when it is completed late this year or early in 1967. The old building will become a parking lot for Spivey's restaurant at Water and Ocean street.
