ARSON INQUIRY

\$500,000 UCSC Inferno Guts Campus Building

SANTA CRUZ — A \$500,000 fire, possibly the work of an arsonist, all but destroyed the Central Services Building on the University of California, Santa Cruz, campus early Thursday morning.

Arson experts sifted through the debris in a preliminary investigation Thursday afternoon but found no evidence the fire was set, authorities said.

State fire marshals are due here today to continue the investigation.

Firemen suspect arson because of the rapidity in which the flames spread.

The blaze started in or near Chancellor Dean E. McHenry's office. Two campus police officers on patrol spotted smoke coming from the building about 2 a.m. and radioed the fire department for help. The officers said the building was almost "totally

engulfed in flames" minutes after they went to investigate the smoke.

Although some new student admission records were destroyed in the fire, most university records in the building were found intact. They
