

NEW CATHOLIC H. S. TO HAVE 50 ENROLLED AUG 27 1930

With an initial enrollment expected to reach the 50 mark, Chaminade high school, a new educational institution in Santa Cruz county, will open next Tuesday in its new \$50,000 building just east of this city.

The institution, founded by the Brothers of Mary, a Catholic educational order, has a 300 acre campus. It will draw boys from both Santa Cruz and Watsonville and from the territory between. A bus will run from this city each morning and return in the afternoon, and a similar service will be maintained by the Catholic parish of Watsonville.

Two Buildings Done

The school will open with two buildings, a main structure 160 by 66 feet and a gymnasium 100 by 65 feet. Plans for future development call for a dormitory and other buildings as its development warrants.

The school will this year give three years of high school and seventh and eighth grade work. Next year it is expected to offer the full high school course. Four members of the order of Brothers of Mary will constitute the faculty this year.

Brother Joseph Principal

The principal will be Brother Joseph Jannings, who came here from Cathedral Latin high school, maintained by the teaching order in Cleveland, Ohio. The previous year he taught in a school in Japan. Brother Joseph will teach third year high school work. Brother Victor will have second year high school subjects and Brother George the seventh and eighth grades. The fourth member of the faculty is expected to arrive tomorrow from the headquarters of the order, in Dayton, Ohio.

Brother George Sauters, inspector of the order, who was in Santa Cruz last spring to make plans for the new institution and to let the contract for the building, which went to J. Michaud of Watsonville, will be here next week.

Six Class Rooms

The main building just completed in time for the opening of the school next Tuesday, is two stories, of Spanish type architecture. On its second floor are six class rooms, four office rooms and the library. On the ground floor are the assembly room, laboratory, recreation room, cafeteria and kitchen, and store rooms.

To celebrate the opening of the new school a barbecue and program will be given on its grounds September 14, for which plans are being made by the Knights of Columbus of Santa Cruz and Watsonville.

In active charge of the construction work has been Brother Charles, head of the group of members of the order who have maintained a residence at Villa Santa Cruz, near the site of the new school, for the last four years.

Bus From Santa Cruz

The bus from Santa Cruz, which will be provided by Father P. J. McGrath, will leave Holy Cross church in this city at 8:15 each morning, stop at the post office corner at 8:20 and arrive at the school at 8:30. A similar service, to be instituted by Father Dumas of Watsonville, will ply between that city and the school.
