Students preserve history of storm

An oral history of the Winter Storm of 1982 has been completed by the students of two Composition I classes at Harbor High School, according to Julie Minnis, supervising teacher of the project.

Under her supervision, Minnis says the students interviewed people in the county who had been personally affected by the disaster.

The interviews were recorded and writ-

ten, then brought to class to be shared with the other students, says Minnis. They were eventually rewritten into a descriptive paper about those experiences, she adds.

Minnis says the people interviewed were from Soquel, Santa Cruz, Ben Lomond and Lockhart Gulch. In an effort to preserve the oral history, Minnis says

she had the 60 stories bound into volumes titled, "Santa Cruz: Natural Disaster 1982."

The formal presentation of the volumes will be made to Principal Marty Krovetz and Librarian Jane Bradford for cataloguing into the school library Wednesday at 10 a.m. in the Harbor High School library.
