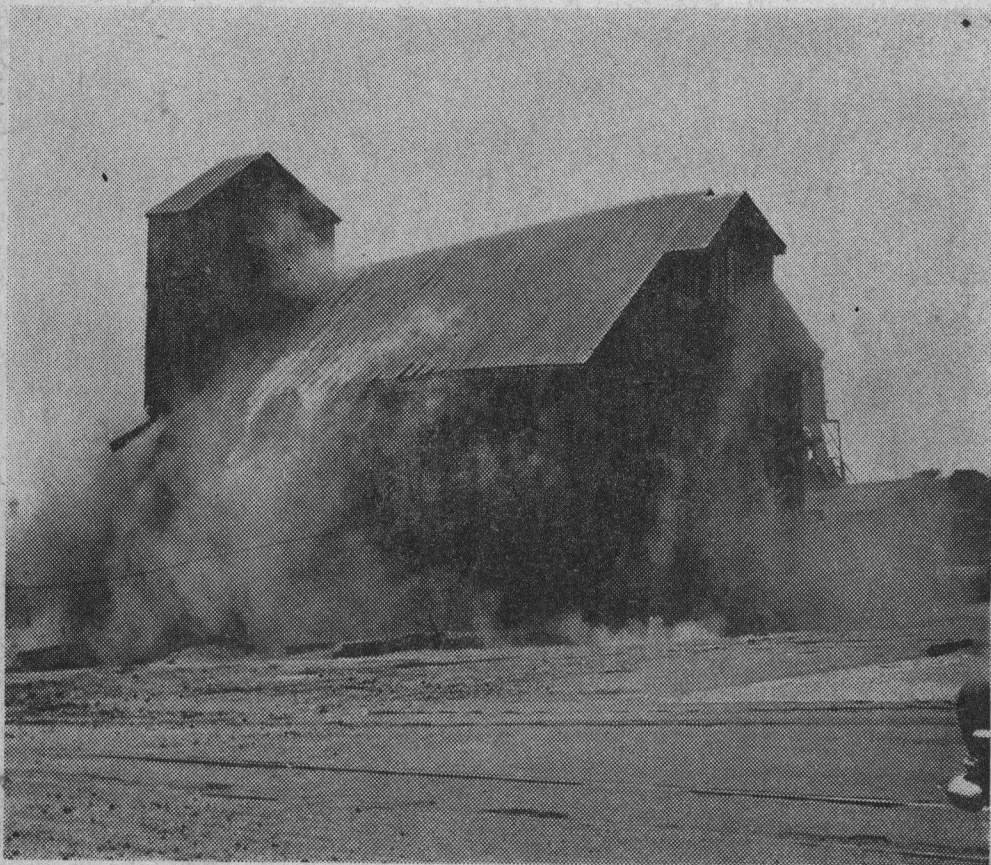
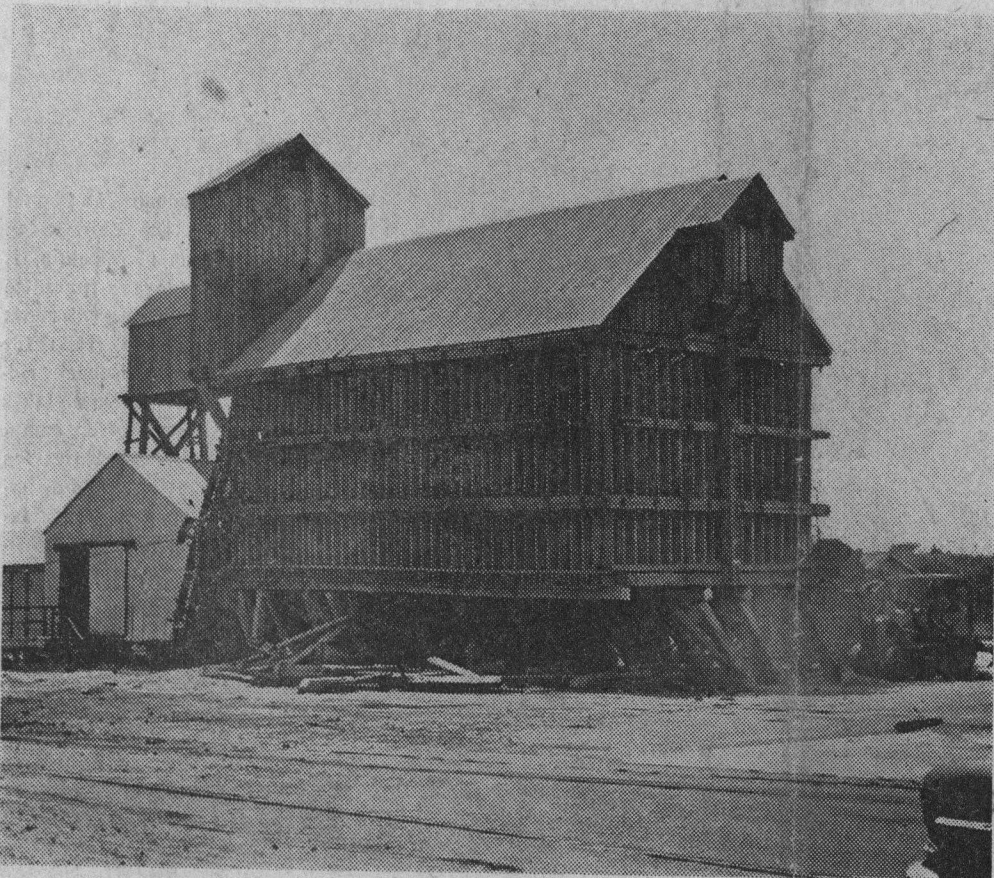

A Landmark Loses After Valiant Struggle



Another landmark bit the dust yesterday when workmen demolished the old sand and gravel storage building of Central Supply Company, on Chestnut Street south of the Union Ice Company

plant. The structure, which was built in about 1924, was used until about three years ago, according to John H. Larkin, operations manager, who supervised the demolition. The work was done by Kester

and Son under a contract with Central Supply, which is a division of Granite Rock Company. The photos record the death of the old building, which put up a valiant fight for life against the wrecker's

bulldozer and cables. But, as the lower right photo shows, the machines finally won. Larkin said the work was done by his company voluntarily as part of a general clean-up of the area.
