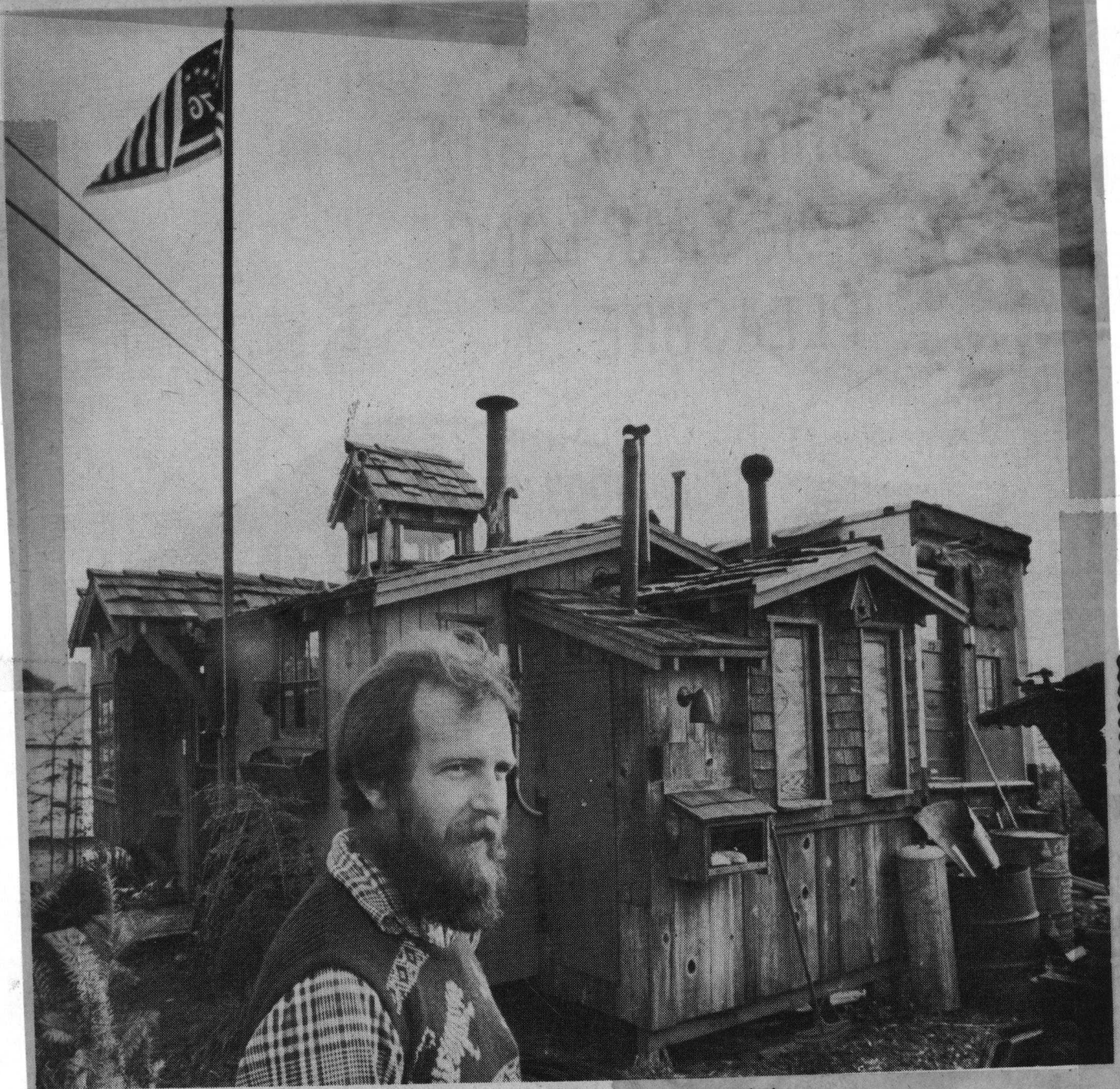
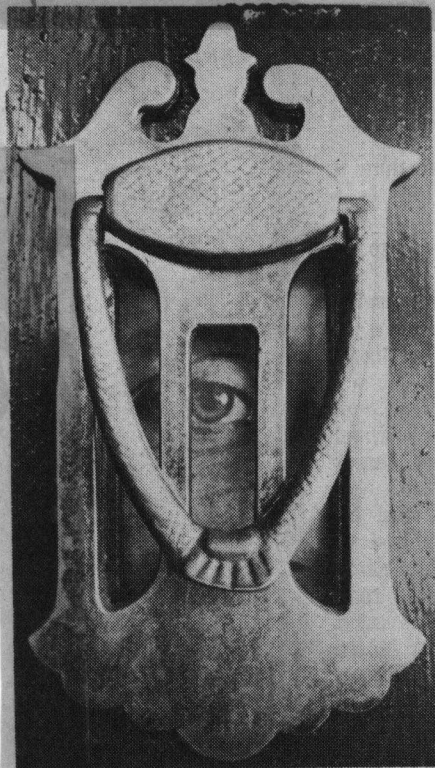

## A house with a difference

Tucked behind a stand of trees off Soquel Ave. just south of Cabrillo College is an unusual house, one built of used lumber, stained glass and flea market pick-ups. The three-room house has such features as Dutch door, paneled walls, shake roof and cupola, topped off with a flag pole from which flutters each day one of 30 flags owned by the house's creator and caretaker, Lee Jon Baker. The building served as a farm worker's house before Baker converted it.
