

Revenge on any level of basketball is sweet. But a recent win for the Santa Cruz Rollercoasters was a special one to savor.

The Rollercoasters, in their inaugural year as a member of the Northern California Wheelchair Basketball Conference, avenged a season-opening loss to Santa Rosa with a 41-37 overtime victory at Watsonville High Dec. 16 for their first-ever win.

"Up there (in Santa Rosa) they beat us in the fourth quarter with a fullcourt press," said 'Coaster Ted Kamo. "We'd only been practicing for a few months together and we just fell apart.
