Board Steps Up Courthouse Plans

The pace is being stepped up in preparing the preliminary plans for the new \$1.6 million county courthouse which is expected to be constructed this summer.

Supervisor Lewis Nelson, a member of the board's building committee, reported yesterday afternoon that beginning next Tuesday weekly planning sessions will be held here with the San Francisco architectural firm of John Lyon Reid and Partners.

Architect Burton L. Rockwell Jr., pastor in the firm, met with Nelson at length Tuesday.

Preliminary plans are scheduled to come before the board sometime in mid-February for approval. The preliminary design of the courthouse won the San Francisco architectural firm a citation last Friday night from the American Institute of Architects.

Nelson was confident the board and the Santa Cruz urban redevelopment agency would come to terms soon on the cost of a portion of URA property to be included in the 7½-acre site. The agency wants \$395,000, while the county is offering \$350,000.
