

Construction runs ahead of schedule

SANTA CRUZ — The new transit center just south of Pacific Garden Mall is ahead of schedule in its construction and should be ready by next April. "But it's too early to predict we'll beat the scheduled April 4, 1984, completion date," says Scott Galloway, general manager of the Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District. Along with the new transit center will be the extension of the mall southward, and that work is already well under way. The new transit center will provide inside and outside waiting rooms, restrooms, parking for up to 20 buses, six concessions outside and two to three shops inside along with a cafe and sidewalk restaurant. Total cost is \$3.1 million, including the land.
