# Regents Okay Capital Outlay Funds For UC

Approval of capital outlay projects, including \$6,024,400 in state funds, for construction at the Santa Cruz campus of the University of California in fiscal 1964-65 was given by the Board of Regents today in a meeting at Riverside.

The funds were part of a \$78.4 million capital outlay budget for statewide UC construction. They will be submitted to the state department of finance for consideration in the 1964-65 state budget.

Also approved was a five-year plan for expansion of university facilities which includes \$27,927,000 for the Santa Cruz campus.

Included in the funds for 64-65 at Santa Cruz are:

Library Unit 1, \$2,680,200; equipment for Natural Sciences Unit 1, \$614,000; utilities and site development \$1,042,000; working drawings and start of construction for Residential College 2, \$974,800; equipment for Residential Unit 1, \$110,000; books for library, \$200,000; playing fields and field house, \$270,000.

Included in the five-year plan are more funds for utilities and site development, Fine Arts building, Natural Sciences Unit 2, Engineering Unit 1, Social Sciences Unit 1, Residential Colleges 3, 4, and 5; Physical Education Unit 1, Engineering Laboratory Unit 1, University House and funds for future planning and development.

The funds approved by the regents were only state funds and do not include funds to be used for capital outlay from other sources such as gifts, loans, etc.

On a statewide basis, the 5-year plan calls for \$368 million in new development including \$35.7 million at Berkeley, \$38.2 at UCLA, \$60.3 at Davis, \$35.4 at Riverside, \$44.4 at Santa Barbara, \$31 million at San Diego, \$22.2 at Irvine, \$17.2 million at San Francisco medical, \$15.6 million at Los Angeles medical and \$30 million at San Diego medical.
