Old Courthouse Bid Entered

The developer of the Old Town shopping complex in Los Gatos, Max W. Walden, has submitted a bid of \$75,000 to rehabilitate the old county courthouse. The county's minimum asking price was \$75,000.

Walden also said he would contribute \$6,000 to rehabilitate the area between the courthouse and the Hall of Records.

A county committee will meet Wednesday noon with Walden to discuss his plans after county supervisors referred the bid to them this morning. The committee consists of Peter W. Harker, real property manager for the county; citizen Chuck Abbott, Supervisors George Cress and Ralph Sanson, City Manager Dave Koester, Mayor Ernest Wicklund, County Counsel Howard Gawthrop, Jerry Hughes, county director of parks and recreation, and Jim Evans, assistant county administrative officer.
