
Proposed School For Severely Mentally Retarded



Bids for the proposed school for severely mentally retarded children in Santa Cruz county will be opened soon. The school, pictured above, will be on the site of the new Freedom school

on Calabassas road. The wing for the mentally retarded children will have three classrooms and will be used by 36 students between the ages of 5 and 21.

Overall estimated cost of the building, grounds, improvements and furniture is about \$100,000, according to Richard Struck, director of guidance and special education for the

county. The students now are scattered throughout the county in various schools. Architect for the project is Bruce Hosier of San Francisco.
