You're Invited to Vote For Town Clock Medallion

The Town Clock Restoration contest for a design for a fund-raising medallion has resulted in three finalists, it has been announced.

They are: Thomas Smith of Felton, Kermit Darrow and P. J. Branum, both of Santa Cruz.

The public is to have the final choice as to winner and the two runners up, announced Joyce Penny Strong who is in charge of the contest.

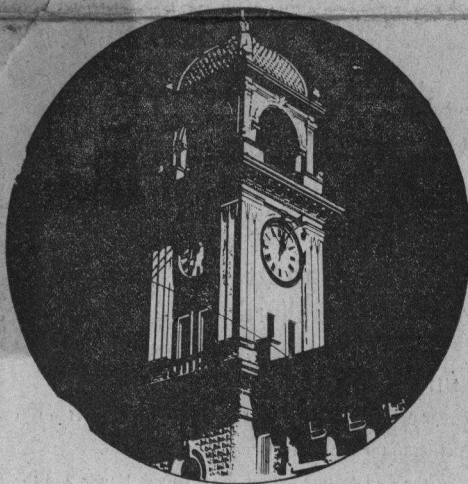
Citizens are asked to vote by writing their choice for first, second and third place on a piece of paper and mailing it to Mrs. Strong at 115 Sylvar Street, Santa Cruz, 95060. They also may vote by stopping in at the Santa Cruz Central Library where there will be a display of the three top designs and ballots available for voting.

Deadline for voting is July 19, 1975. First place winner will receive \$25 in cash, a bronze medallion and a \$20 gift certificate from Lenz Arts.

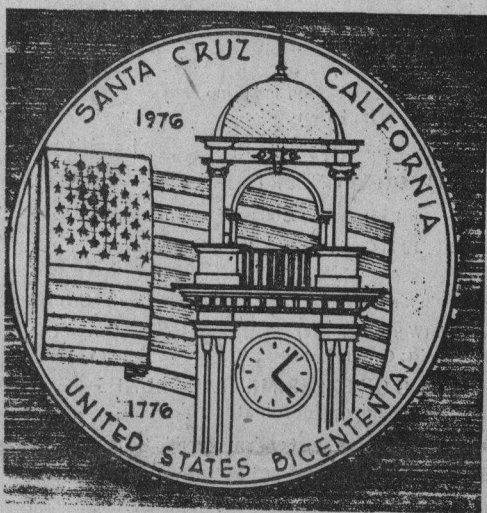
The two runners up will each receive a \$10 gift certificate donated by Palace Stationers and Eastside Paint and Wallpaper.

The contest is the kick-off event in a year-long campaign to raise money and spur interest in the Town Clock restoration project on a site approved by the city, at the lower Plaza. July 1976 is the target date for completion.

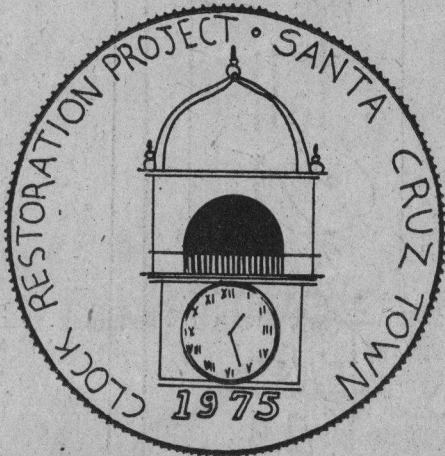
Spearheading the clock project is the Citizens Committee for Community Improvement, with Robert Darrow as chairman.
