for repairing the structure. This is one of the chief projects of the Felton Fire department which has collected \$750 for the work. owned bridge as soon as plans are finished. When the bridge was damaged in the 1955 flood, the county spent \$2000 for lumber and Granite Construction company did the repair work. The bridge is located in Felton Grove and crosses the San Lorenzo river.
