## RESOLUTION CPC-64-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ ADOPTING A GENERAL PLAN FOR THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ENVIRONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT SANTA CRUZ, AS A PART OF THE GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ, AND RECOMMENDING THE ADOPTION OF SAID GENERAL PLAN BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ AS PROVIDED BY THE PLANNING LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Cruz, the County of Santa Cruz, and the Regents of the University of California have heretofore recognized the need for the development of a General Plan by which to guide the future growth of the environs of the campus of the University of California at Santa Cruz; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County of Santa Cruz, under a joint exercise of powers agreement, have entered into an agreement with the State of California to provide Urban Planning Assistance under Section 701 of the Federal Housing Act of 1954, as amended, under which agreement such a General Plan was caused to be prepared; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission of the City of Santa Cruz, on March 26, 1964, continued to April 8, 1964, and on April 9, 1964, held duly advertised and open public hearings on the proposed General Plan for the University Environs as required by the Planning Laws of the State of California and the Charter of the City of Santa Cruz; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to such public hearings, the City Planning Commission took under advisement the proposed General Plan for the University Environs along with such comments, suggestions and objections as had been submitted, both orally and in writing, in connection with the Plan, prior to or during the public hearings; and

WHEREAS, following due discussion and deliberation of the Plan and such comments, suggestions and objections as were submitted, the City Planning Commission did determine the Plan to be an acceptable and desirable one subject to certain modifications;
