Supervisors Vote To Establish Second In Command At Juvenile Hall

By a split 3-to-2 vote, the board of supervisors this morning indicated it will set up a "second in command" at Juvenile Hall.

Supervisors instructed County Counsel Bill Card to draft an ordinance establishing the position of senior group supervisor at a salary of \$433 to \$527 a month.

Robert Burton and Vince Locatelli voted against the proposal. Three public hearings on the ordinance are yet to come.

County Personnel Director Charles Shean said the new job would allow someone to take over the hall's administrative responsibilities when Superintendent Lavone Kindall is absent.

Chief Probation Officer Jim Solomon explained that when Kindall is away now the male group supervisor on duty assumes administrative responsibility. He added that sometimes these supervisors have only "two weeks of experience."

Solomon added that the senior group supervisor would be in charge during Kindall's vacation and sick leave time. The senior supervisor also would be the head

of the hall on weekends. Solomon said that Kindall now is called to duty on many weekends.

Shean added that the senior position would be a reclassification of a male supervisor position now on the staff. No new employees would be required.

Burton said the proposal should have been placed before the board during budget time.

Solomon answered that he arrived in Santa Cruz after the probation department 1963-64 budget had been submitted to the board. Because of his unfamiliarity with the local set-up, Solomon said he didn't want to change the budget proposal then.

Other items considered this morning by the board include:

OVERTIME — Overtime was granted to the following departments: sheriff's office, \$539;

county jail, \$52; county hospital, \$497; public works department, \$81.

ASSESSMENT CLERK — The county civil service commission notified the board that the position of stenographer clerk II has been changed to assessment clerk II in the county assessor's office.

POSITIONS — The board approved filling of the following positions: two nursing attendants for county hospital; assistant county counsel I to replace Assistant County Counsel III John Sanbrook, who has been selected county counsel of Yuba county.

APTOS — A public hearing was set for December 30 at 10:30 a.m. to consider annexing Park Wilshire subdivision to the Aptos sanitation district.
