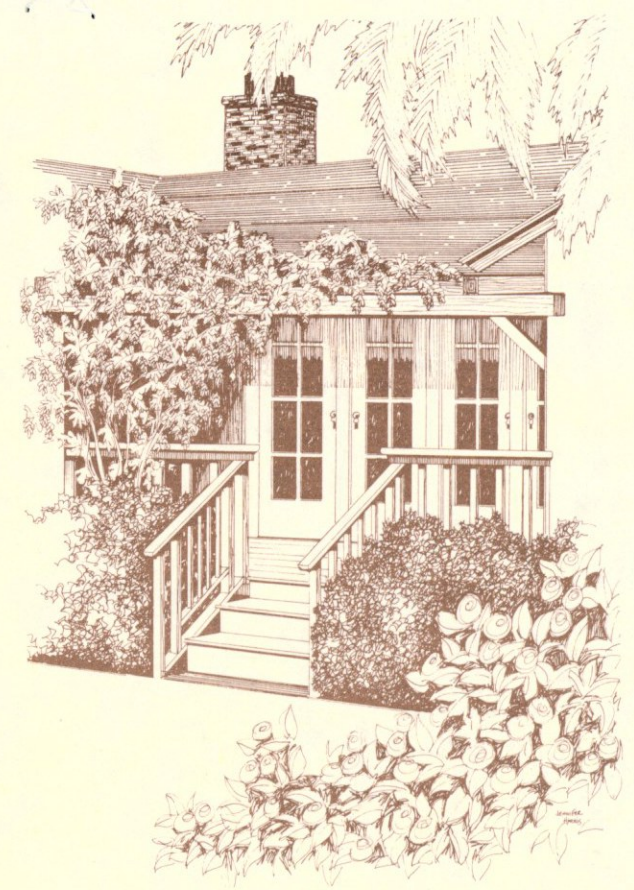
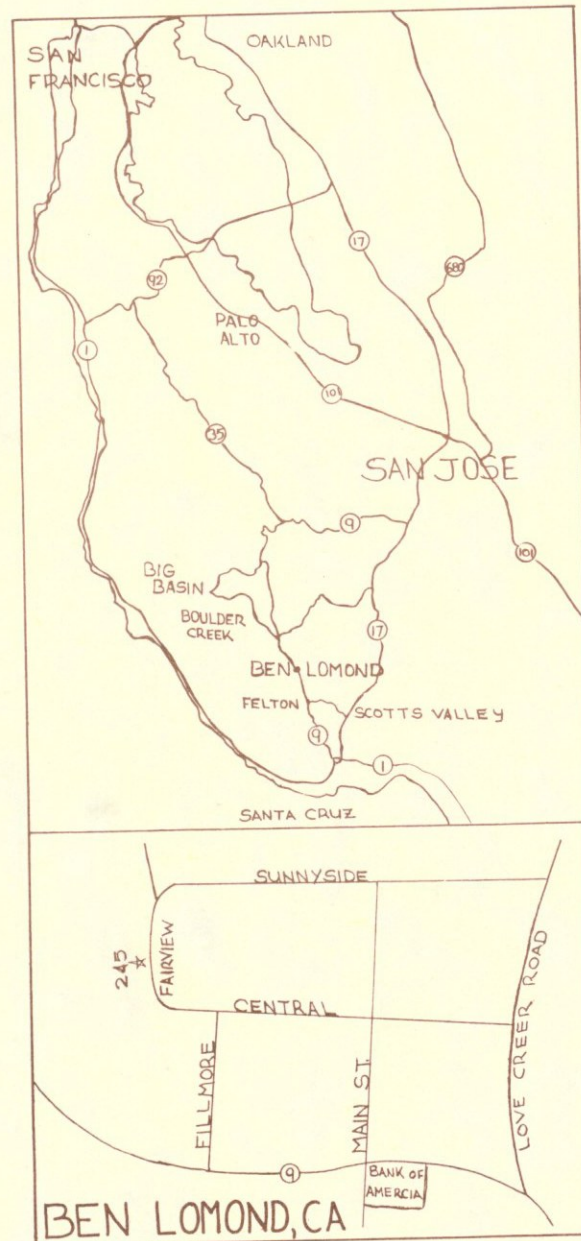

## Nearby Santa Cruz . . .

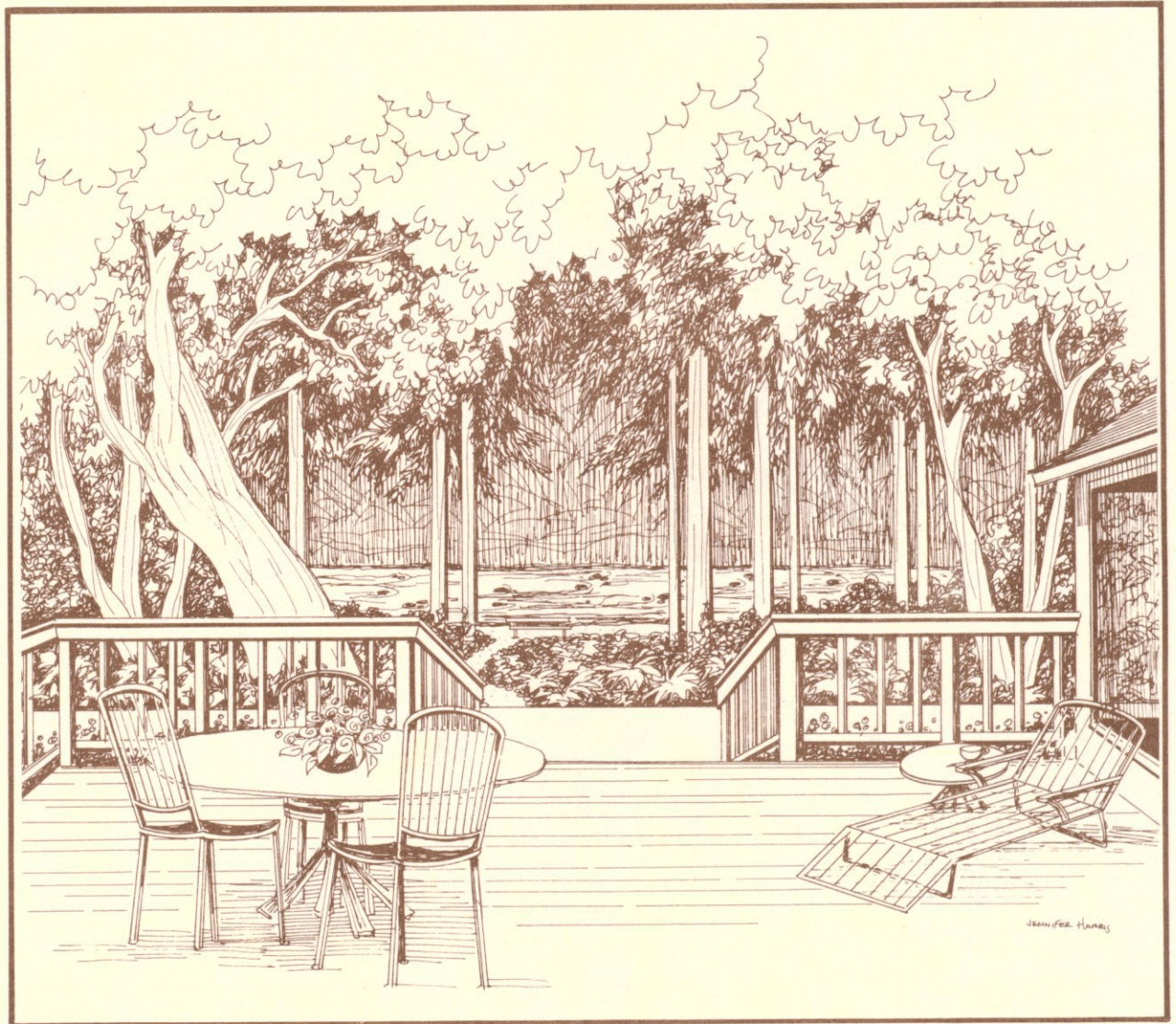

## History . . .

Fairview Manor was once the site of the old Ben Lomond Hotel that was destroyed by fire in 1906. The present home was built by a well known patent attorney, N. A. Acker in 1924. This prominent San Francisco family used the home as their summer residence for many years. The home was maintained by the family until 1981 when the present owners acquired the property. Much of the original landscaping remains and helps to create an ambience that speaks of an earlier, quieter time.
