The controversial plan for a Scotts Valley community services district may crumble tomorrow at the continued hearing before the board of supervisors.

At 3 p.m., the board is scheduled to take up the issue.

Two circumstances are responsible for the forecast of doom. The assessor's office has not been able to plot a map showing the properties to be excluded. Secondly, time is rapidly running out on the four-week limit for exclusion hearings.
