City agrees to bandstand rebuild plan

SANTA CRUZ — The Sabta Cruz Seaside Co. has agreed to rebuild the bandstand on the Main Beach if the city will turn over any federal reimbursement funds it might receive.

The City Council agreed to the

plan Tuesday.

The Seaside Co. built the concrete bandstand in 1963 and turned it over to the city. It was wrecked in the earthquake when the concrete stage shook loose from the vertical

pillars.

The city anticipates a \$300,000 reimbursement from the Federal Emergency Management Agency. A final FEMA decision is expected in two to three weeks, according to Jim Lang, director of parks and recreation. A new bandstand will cost about \$500,000.
